I worked the gun show tables around the state, was asked to serve on the executive committee as a vice president of marketing, then executive vice president from where I was elected to the board of directors. In unison with NRA, we changed the law with all the help from Iowans, and we opted to change our name to the "Iowa Firearms Coalition" to better serve the membership's new broadened direction.

IFC was awarded the coveted "Jay M. Littlefield NRA-ILA Memorial Volunteer Organization of the Year Award" for the work performed to help pass Shall Issue reform, and our president accepted the award on behalf of our membership. Our

organization is 100% volunteer with no paid positions. While we'd very much like to change this and hire a full time executive director, we still need more annual membership to do so. IFC holds a daily presence at the capitol building, and we attend all the DNR public meetings along with the rules committees, and liaise routinely with the Governor's office.
