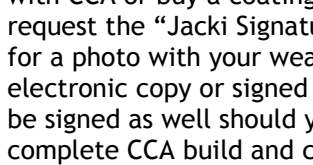
Transforming your weapon—fit, function, appeal.

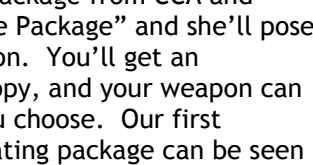

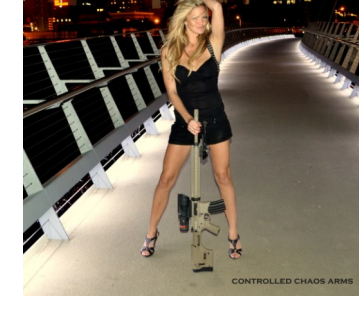

The "Jacki Signature Series" weapon build or coating package promotion.

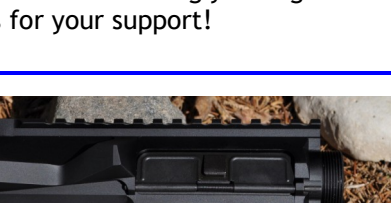

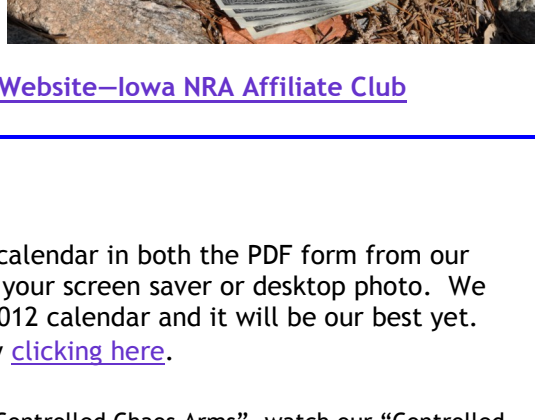
